I would like to thank the APS team for making M/Y Ocean Victory's stay in Asia at Singapore and Langkawi a successful one.

Our experience with Asia Pacific Superyachts began with APS Langkawi. The yacht was there for about 3 months undertaking Warranty works with the yachts builder. Scott Walker and his staff were instrumental in obtaining an agreement with representatives from the build yard to assist with immigration issues and allocating a berth at the Langkawi Cruise Centre. Shipments and requests were met with timely arrangements and deliveries. During our time alongside Asia Pacific Superyachts were quick to assist in outsourcing spares and parts from Singapore and organise their subsequent delivery to Langkawi.
